

Special note for Bulk and Brush Pick up

Thank you for your understanding as The City of Winter Haven Solid Waste Team work to complete clean-up and recovery efforts City-wide following the hurricane.

If you are concerned regarding Hurricane Milton debris, please be advised that the City and subcontractors are working systematically to collect all debris. There is no need to call for collection. At this time, we have paused all bulk collections until all hurricane debris has been collected.

FEMA Debris Removal Guidelines are being followed for the collection of brush and debris which require debris are separated out into piles which will ensure all debris can be picked up in a timely manner. Debris that is not separated may not be picked up on initial passes as it cannot be processed appropriately. No bag brush will be picked up.

For self-hauling, the Polk County North Central Transfer Station will accept all hurricane-related debris at no cost during regular operating hours:
